





Plug-in Conversion Kit Assembly and Installation Instructions

Safety Precautions for Installation:

- This kit is for indoor use only
- Do not allow Kit or lamp to become wet
- This kit is designed for Gypsy Color chandiers and is not guaranteed to work with other products

 <p>Have a professional locate the wood stud behind the sheetrock, drill the pilot hole, and install the screw eye. Proper installation is crucial for any overhead chandelier installation.</p> <p>Ceiling</p> <p>1</p>	 <p>Place the plug-in kit ceiling cap with cord included over the central threaded pipe of the chandelier. Secure the cap to chandelier by screwing on the triangle bolt.</p> <p>2</p>
<p>Tighten screws</p>  <p>The positive wire has writing on it and is marked with a "+" sticker.</p> <p>The center green wire is the ground wire.</p> <p>The negative wire has texture on it and is marked with a "-" sticker.</p> <p>see Note*</p> <p>*Note: The plug-in cord connector may be marked with "L" for Positive and "N" for Negative. If there are no markings on the connector or cord, then it doesn't matter which cord goes to positive and negative wires on the chandelier. There is no ground wire on the cord.</p> <p>3</p>	 <p>Hang chandelier on hook with triangle bolt. Push ceiling cap flush to the ceiling then tighten the small side screw to keep cap in place.</p> <p>4</p>
